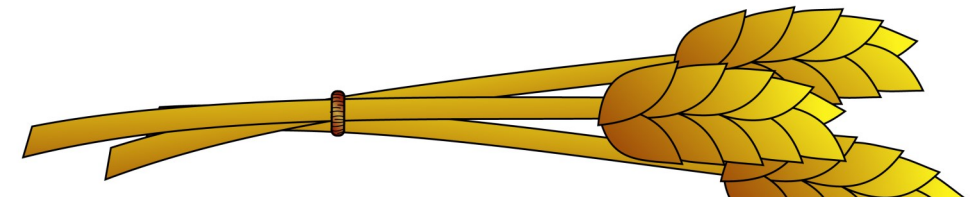
LEST WE FORGET

If your loved one is a Veteran, please drop off their dress uniform/dress shirt and pants/metals if available by November 6th.

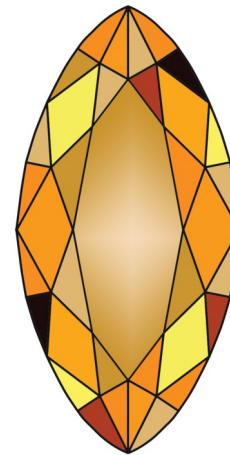

Birthstone of the Month - Yellow Topaz

Topaz, the birthstone for November, likely gets its name from the Red Sea's Island of Topazios (now called Zabargad). Pure topaz is a colorless or "white" stone. It's often tinged with other minerals to create shades of pink, orange, and blue, but it is most commonly found in hues of yellow and gold. The ancient Greeks associated topaz with strength. In the Middle Ages, it was thought to convey invisibility. During the Renaissance, Europeans believed this was the stone to use to break a magic spell.



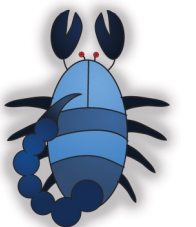
Flower of the Month - Chrysanthemum

These beautiful blooms, more commonly called tansies or mums, generally signify optimism and cheerfulness, but they can have different meanings depending on their color. For example, red signifies love, white represents truth, and yellow is the color for unrequited love. In Asian countries, chrysanthemums have been brewed into teas and made into wines to cure fevers and increase longevity for centuries. In North American tradition, mums are a friendship flower and a lovely gift for expressing your appreciation for your best pals.

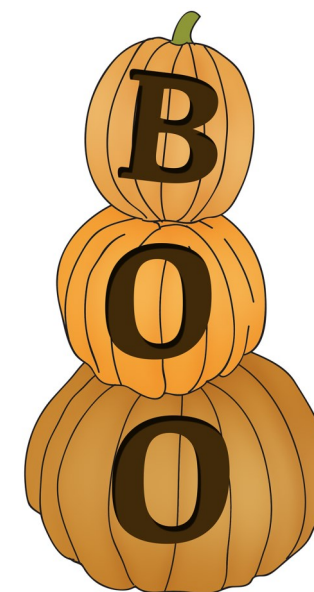
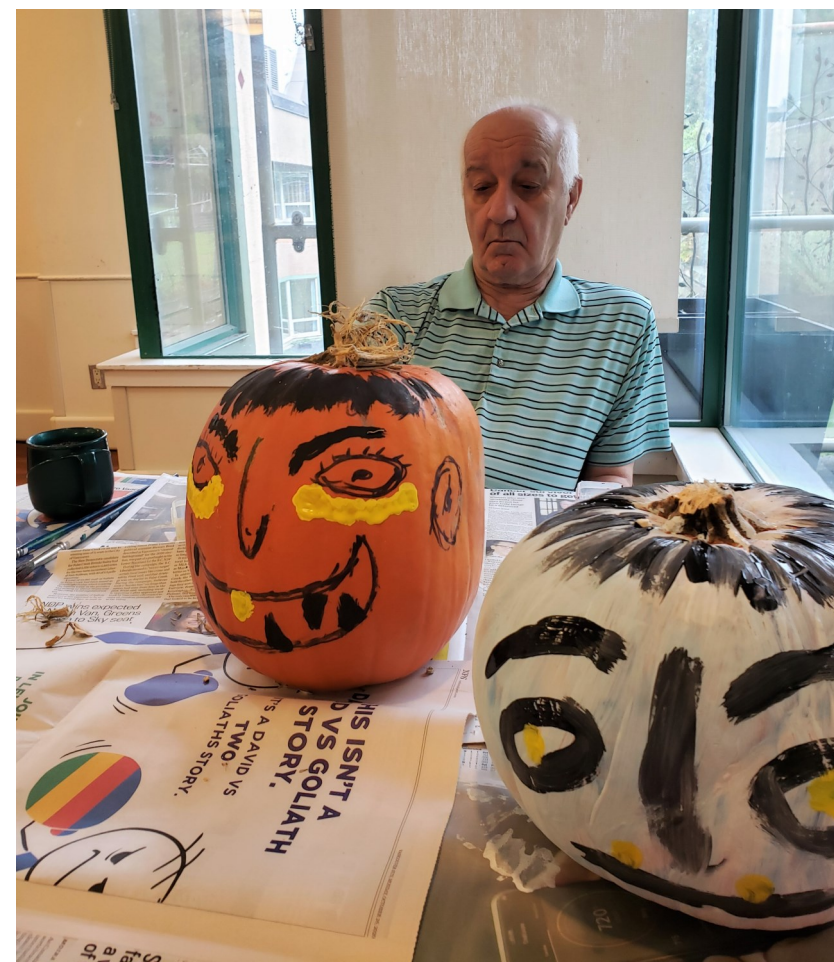
